

BRIDGE 2624 - REPLACEMENT

(TERRITORIAL ROAD, FLORENCE TOWNSHIP)



Bridge #2624 in Florence Township has carried Territorial Road traffic over Wells Creek just one mile south of Frontenac Station for almost 100 years. It is one of the last truss bridges in Goodhue County, a “pony” truss constructed in 1917. Federal bridge funds are being used to pay for the work, and its replacement will be a pre-stressed concrete girder structure identified as bridge #25613. Construction has begun with the removal of the old structure on September 16th. We are hoping to have this project completed yet this construction season.
