

CSAH 6 – GRADING & SURFACING

(FROM CSAH 9 TO CSAH 1)



This project is slated to begin at the end of July 2014. We will be regrading CSAH 6 to moderate some of the hills, dips, and curves, and to provide a wider shoulder area along the road. Preliminary survey has already begun (you may notice the survey stakes along the road), final plans have been developed and we anticipate Federal approval within the next week. The existing pavement will be completely removed, ground up, and incorporated into the new grade. The road will be closed during the grading process (except to local traffic), which will hopefully be completed by fall of 2014. The road will be open during the winter months with an aggregate surface. The new road will be concrete, and the paving process will begin in the summer of 2015 under a future contract.

This will be a huge improvement for people who travel this roadway. Rising oil prices have made the cost of concrete and bituminous pavement much closer in cost than historical figures. We are excited to be able to provide a more navigable and longer-lasting roadway in this area.
