

PROPERTY AND BUILDINGS-ORDINANCE NO. 2-80

Public Nuisance Regarding Goodhue County Property and Buildings.

A. Public Nuisance Defined. Whoever intentionally performs one of these listed acts is guilty of a public nuisance, a misdemeanor.

1. Interferes with, obstructs, or blocks, alone or in concert with others, public walks, hallways, aisles, and right-of-ways on Goodhue County Property; Or
2. Sits or stands upon walls or other structures belonging to Goodhue County and not designed as a chair, bench or structure for seating; or
3. Places or deposits litter or refuse, including but not limited to paper, wrappings, containers, and cigarettes, upon Goodhue County property; or
4. Loiters, walks, sits, or stands upon Goodhue County property while having no business to attend to with Goodhue County or having no reason to be upon Goodhue County property; or
5. Damages or destroys grass, lawns, trees, and shrubs belonging to Goodhue County.

B. Reimbursements for Damages Caused By Public Nuisances. In addition to the criminal penalty of a misdemeanor, a person found guilty of public nuisance may be required to pay to Goodhue County a sum of money to reimburse Goodhue County for damages done by the act or acts of public nuisances.
