## **Adults Need Immunizations Too**



**Why do adults need immunizations?**

*Getting immunized is a lifelong, life-protecting job. Approximately 50,000 deaths could be prevented each year if American adults obtained routine vaccinations. Ask your healthcare provider what vaccinations are recommended for you.*



**What immunizations are available for adults?**

*Goodhue County Public Health Service is currently offering tetanus-diphtheria-pertussis, pneumonia, HPV (Gardasil), MMR (measles, mumps, rubella), Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, chickenpox vaccinations to eligible adults. The vaccine is provided through a Minnesota Department of Health program.*



**Who is considered an "eligible" adult?**

*Any adult 19 years or older, who is uninsured or under-insured can receive the above immunizations. Under-insured means your insurance will not pay for a vaccination because you haven't met the deductible, or have reached an annual cap. Check with your insurance company if you're not sure.*



**How much will it cost?**

*Goodhue County Public Health Service offers the immunizations to eligible adults for \$14.00 per immunization to cover the cost of administering the vaccine, however no one will be turned away for an inability to pay.*



**Do I need an appointment?**

*Goodhue County Public Health Service has walk-in immunization clinics on every Tuesday of each week in our Red Wing office @ 512 West 6th Street, from 2pm - 4pm. No appointment is needed.*
