Projects Completed in 2022:

1. County ARPA Funded Broadband Grant Program
2. Moved district court to separate VOIP phone system
3. Completed Physical Inventory of all County IT Hardware
4. Implemented physical Election Security/Monitoring systems
5. Implemented Electronic Document Management System (EDMS) for Human Resources
6. County Email migrated to Microsoft Office365
7. Migration of HHS EDMS (OnBase) to new CaseWorks system
8. Implemented new Disk-to-Disk network Backup System
9. Implemented new GIS network file storage

Projects Started in 2022:

1. Upgrade of Property Tax System for Auditor/Treasurer Office
2. Continue migration to Microsoft Office365 – Teams, OneDrive, SharePoint
3. Upgrade Pine Island and Wanamingo GCSO Offices
4. Assist Public Works with Lake Byllesby Park Pavilion Security
5. Implement Information Security Awareness Program – ARPA Funding
