RE: Grading of County Road 6 Boulevard in Zumbrota between Trunk Highway 58 and 435th St.

Work is scheduled to begin on the County Road 6 grading project Monday, August 17, 2020. This work will be a complete regrade of the existing road including the removal of the existing surfacing, widening of the road section, utility relocation, and City of Zumbrota sewer and water services.

Due to the complex nature of the project and access issues the project will be built in phases.

Phase 1: From the north entrance of Central Livestock to the existing concrete at 435th St...

Work will include: pavement removal, grading, centerline pipe, and aggregate surfacing of the completed road. This work is anticipated to be completed by the end of September. Access to all local residents and businesses will be from the south during this work including the residents that access County Road 6 at Golf Links Ave and Sugarloaf Parkway. No through traffic will be allowed on the project and should follow the marked detour. At the completion of this phase all traffic from Central Livestock, Sugarloaf Parkway, and Golf Links Ave. will be expected to access their residences and business from the north. The Zumbrota Township road of 430th St. will be marked as a detour route for car traffic. Truck traffic will not be permitted on 430th St. with this type of traffic being required to use the designated truck detour that goes to County Road 9 and then south on County Road 6. Residents that access County Road 6 from 435th St. will need to use 430th St. for the duration of the project when traveling to Trunk Highway 58 and Zumbrota.

Phase 2: From the south entrance of Central Livestock to Trunk Highway 58.

Work will include: pavement removal, grading, City of Zumbrota sewer & water, and aggregate surfacing of the completed road. This work is anticipated to be completed by the end of November. Residents in this area will be provided access to the south by means of Trunk Highway 58 and by using Walnut St. to the east out to Trunk Highway 58. Truck traffic will not be allowed to use Walnut St. and these vehicles should follow the signed truck detour. The residents on Aqua Drive will have access from the Trunk Highway 58 end of the project. There may be times when access will be from Walnut St. or the south end of County Road 6 due to the sewer and water operation. No through traffic will be allowed on the project and should follow the marked detour.

Local traffic should be aware that you are driving in a construction zone when within the project limits and a reduced speed is advised. Being aware of the changing conditions, equipment working around you, and construction personnel is very important.
