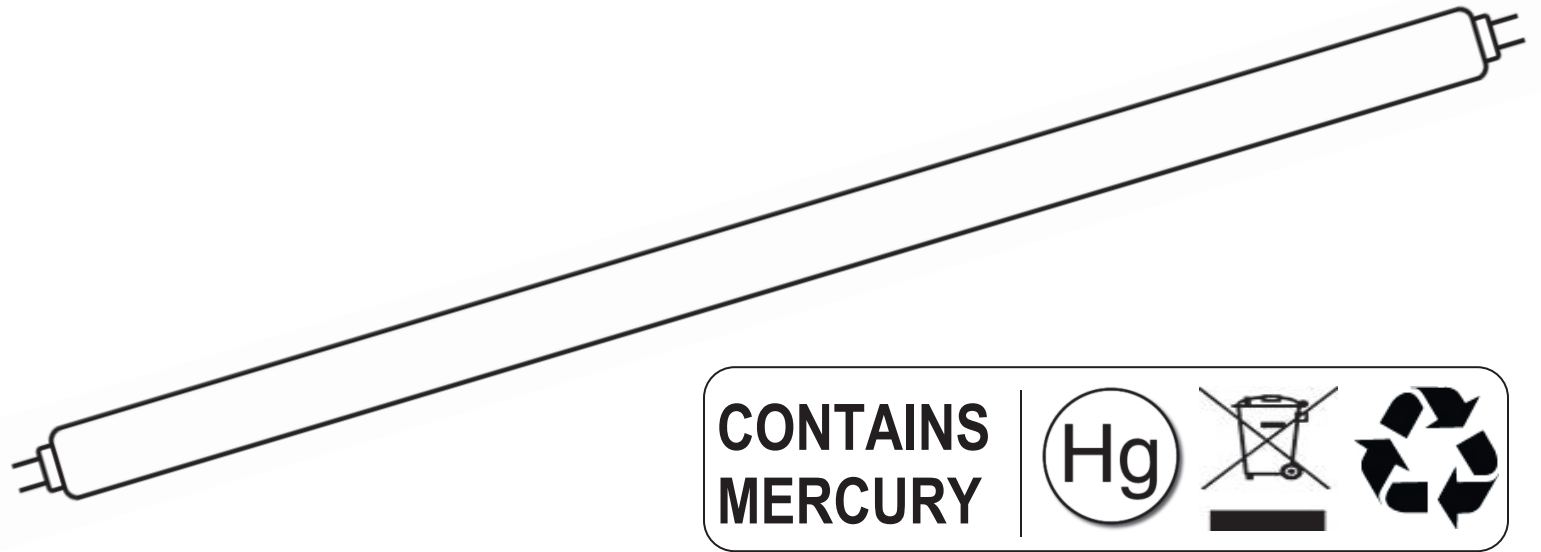


Fluorescent bulbs save energy and reduce environmental pollution.

## **Fluorescent and LED Bulb Disposal Information**

Fluorescent and LED bulb disposal is available at the Goodhue County Recycling Center Monday through Friday (except holidays), between the hours of 8:00am and 3:00pm, year-round. Please bring your fluorescent and LED bulbs to the Recycling Center and place them in barrels available inside the Goodhue County Recycling Center accessed through the south side entry door to the Recycling Center.

Households can bring up to 10/year for free, after that they will be charged .50¢/bulb.

Businesses will be charged .50¢/bulb and will need to set up a time to drop off their bulbs. Please call 651-385-3109 to set up a time for bulb drop off.
