Summary

It is requested that the County Board award the contract for concrete paving County State Aid Highways (CSAH) 1 & 21 to the lowest responsible bidder.

Background

Bids for the concrete and bituminous paving of approximately 8.0 and 1.3 miles, respectively, of CSAH 1 from TH 60 to TH 52 and the concrete paving of approximately 0.21 miles of CSAH 21 from TH 58 to 170' east of Eagle Ridge Drive were opened Tuesday, February 27, 2018.

Alternatives

- Award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder.
- Reject all bids.

Recommendations

It is the recommendation of staff to award the CSAH 1 & 21 Concrete Paving Contract to PCI Roads, LLC with the lowest responsible bid of \$6,093,122.16; additionally, staff is requesting change order authority not to exceed 10% of the approved bid.

County Planner and Zoning Administrator, Mike Wozniak and County Commissioner, Brad Anderson attended the meeting. Township Supervisors and those in attendance at the meeting were briefed on the items under review by the County by Mike Wozniak. The Township Board accepted comments from those in attendance. Comments and concerns expressed by property owners along County Road 41 between Augie's Trucking and State Highway 19 were similar to those made to the County Planning Advisory Commission.

Summary

The Planning Advisory Commission considered if the proposed expansion of Augie's Trucking would essentially double the size and scope of the operation and potentially result in a business that would no longer be appropriate for its location.

The primary concerns regarding the proposed expansion of Augie's Trucking was an increase in nuisance impacts to nearby residents including dust, noise and traffic safety concerns. These are the issues that the public identified when the CUP was initially considered by the PAC in October 2016.

The business is located on County Road 41 approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile from State Highway 19. There are seven dwelling sites along County Road 41 between State Highway 19 and Augie's Trucking. County Road 41 is a gravel road and the truck traffic from Augie's Trucking must negotiate a hill and curves when traveling to or from the Augie's Trucking site to State Highway 41.

The applicant proposed expansion includes the following:

1. Shop Building would double in size from 40 x 50 feet to 80 x 100 feet. The application notes that the shop addition will make it necessary to relocate (replace) the septic system for the building. LP Tanks will need to be moved as well.
2. The application submittal also notes that an existing granary building is being used for business related storage.
3. The maximum number of non-resident employees would increase from 6 employees to 12 employees.
4. A proposed increase in the number of trucks that may be parked on-site from 5 trucks to 10 trucks; the submittal states that the trucks are typically expected to make two trips per day resulting in 40 vehicle trips per day for the trucking business.
5. Expansion of current parking area (estimated to be 130 x 150 feet from 2016 application site plan), expanding by 130 x 66 feet (estimated final dimensions 130x 216 feet) adding an additional 10 trailer parking spots, making it easier to turn around and move equipment. The application submittal also notes the planned maximum site capacity/occupancy of: 10 Trucks and 15 trailers. *Expansion of the parking area will result in some clearing of trees along the southwest corner of the site.*
6. A new larger sign, the applicant has stated that currently there are signs at the end of each driveway labeling them Private/Deliveries. They are proposing a new larger sign at the end of the "business" driveway (identified on proposed site plan). *County sign regulations limited the size of signs for Commercial or Industrial Businesses that primarily serve the Agricultural Community to 64 square feet.*
7. Additional exterior lighting is being proposed for the new shop addition for safety and security reasons.
8. The Applicant 2018 proposed hours of operation: Monday – Friday 8:00 am to 6:00 pm (sometimes until 9:00 pm) and Weekends varying daytime/early evening hours.

Public Works Director Comments:

After reviewing the proposed changes to the 2016 Jason Augustine/Augie's Trucking CUP, Public Works Director Greg Isakson has raised questions and concerns related to implementing dust control and road safety practices.

Dust control:

If dust control is required by the applicant from his location to Highway 19, it should be determined if it requires one application of chloride per summer or multiple applications. The added truck traffic from Augie's Trucking in addition to the regular traffic using County Road 41, makes it difficult to control the ruts on the gravel surface. If the surface has to be regraded the dust control would most likely have to be reapplied to remain effective. If this is a requirement,

Mr. Augustine would be responsible for contracting with a vendor to apply the chloride. Mr. Augustine's representative indicated that he (Mr. Augustine) does not think he should be required to bear the cost of dust control.

In respect to including a requirement that the Applicant work with Public Works to implement best practices to implement road safety, Mr. Isakson expressed the view that it would necessary to significantly improve the stretch of County road 41 between Augie's Trucking and Hwy 19 to improve safety. This may include regrading and paving that stretch of the gravel road so that it could better stand up to the added truck traffic in addition to the regular traffic using the road. The significant expense of this type of improvement makes this a policy and budgetary matter for the County Board.

Based upon review of the CUP Amendment Application and consideration of comments received from the public, the Planning Advisory Commission has proposed the following Findings of Fact

Findings of fact:

- A. The proposed expansion of Augie's Trucking will make the size and scope of the business incompatible with surrounding land uses and current road infrastructure.
- B. The added impacts of doubling truck traffic on County Road 41, between the Augie's Trucking Site and State Highway 19 will bring added traffic safety and nuisance issues including dust, noise, and fumes to the 7 dwelling sites along that stretch of County Road 41.
- C. The proposed business expansion would result in a business more appropriately located within a business or industrial zone district or in a location that will result in fewer impacts on nearby residential properties.

Planning Advisory Commission Recommendation:

The PAC recommends that the County Board of Commissioners:

- adopt the staff report into the record;
- adopt the findings of fact;
- accept the application, testimony, exhibits, and other evidence presented into the record and;

DENY the request for Expansion and Amendment of an existing CUP Requested by Jason Augustine (applicant/owner) and Augie's Trucking CUP to expand and increase operations on the site including, additional trucking and repair, more parking, and expansion of buildings at PID 42.001.1001, 17510 County 41 Blvd in Vasa Township.

REVIEW OF AUGIE'S TRUCKING EXISTING CUP, Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to operate a trucking and repair business in an A3, Urban Fringe district. Approved by County Board – 11/1/2016 (Doc # 636570) this approval included the condition: *Staff will coordinate a PAC review of the CUP November 2017.*

County Planner and Zoning Administrator, Michael A Wozniak, AICP, conducted a site visit of the Augie's Trucking Property on November 21, 2017. During that visit facilities and operations were observed. Tasha Miller, Office Manager for Augie's Trucking answered questions and provided an overview of current operations. In addition, the County Building Official inspected the shop/office building used for the business on January 24, 2018.

Land Use Management Staff have concluded that the facilities and operation of Augie's Trucking appear to be in conformance with requirements of the Conditional Use Permit (File No. Z16-0073), and with other applicable regulations as follows:

1. The business must comply with all applicable Federal, State and Local Rules and Regulations, including but not limited to building permits and SSTS permits.

To the best understanding of Land Use Management Staff, Augie's Trucking is operating in conformance with applicable Federal, State and Local Rules and Regulations.

2. The applicant shall schedule an inspection by the Goodhue County Building Official to evaluate the accessory structure housing the business for compliance with applicable building code requirements.

The applicant had overlooked scheduling an inspection of the shop/office structure used for business. After being reminded of the requirement the applicant recently scheduled an inspection with Building Official, Doug Morem, which took place on January 24, 2018. Doug has concluded that the existing shop/office building meets applicable building code requirements for its current use.

3. The applicant must provide evidence (copy of completed MPCA Notification/Change in Status for Aboveground Storage Tanks Form) of compliance with MPCA Rules regarding storage and handling of diesel fuel and waste oil.

The applicant has indicated that they do not store fuel on the property and do not exceed 50 gallons of storage of waste oil. Based on the limited volume of waste oil storage they are not subject to having to submit the "MPCA Notification/Change in Status for Aboveground Storage Tank Form".

4. The business shall be limited to parking/storage of no more than five (5) owner- operated trucks (with trailers not limited).

Four trucks were observed on-site during a November 21, 2017, site visit.

5. Business use shall be limited to truck storage, maintenance, and repair, with an accessory building limited to approximately 40' x 90'.

The trucking and truck repair business was observed to be operating within the 40' x 90' (office/shop) during the November 21, 2017 site visit.

6. A maximum of six (6) non-family employees may be employed on the premises at any time.

Three employees were observed on-site during the November 21, 2017 site visit. The applicant has indicated they have not exceeded 4 employees as of yet.

As indicated in the PAC minutes from October 2016, January 2018, and communications with the Land Use Management office, there are continued concerns over traffic safety related to truck traffic traveling between the Augie's Trucking site and State Highway 19 from nearby property owners.

Based upon the review of the existing permit and the expansion request, the PAC members are proposed to the County Board of Commissioners the following Findings of Fact and amendments to the existing CUP:

Findings of Fact:

- It appears that there has been an increase in dust and road wear due to the truck traffic from the business;
- The truck traffic from the business has increased the volume of traffic on County 41. Additional road safety measures resulting from that increased traffic should be addressed;
- Business hours were not specifically established for both the trucking and truck repair operations for the business during the 2016 request. Neighbors have identified concerns with the noise of the trucks starting and leaving the site earlier than 5 am.

- Due to the concerns raised at the meetings, the PAC is requesting another review of the CUP in February 2019

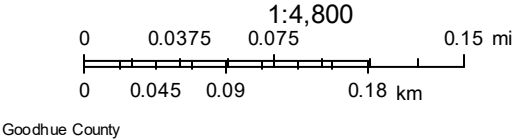

:CUP Expansion of Augie's Trucking in Sec 1 of Vasa Township

At its regular monthly meeting on February 13th the Board heard from both concerned neighbors and Tasha Miller, a representative of Augie's Trucking, about the proposed expansion of Augie's Trucking in Sec 1 of Vasa Township. Michael Wozniak, County Zoning Administrator, was also present to explain to the Board what the Planning Commission had decided on the expansion proposal and on the review of the existing CUP.

After listening to all of the discussion the Board voted 3 to 0 to recommend against the expansion and amendment of the existing CUP.

The Board felt that the most if not all of the safety concerns about truck traffic was due to the poor condition of County 41 and that it would not support the extra traffic that the expansion would create. The Board agreed with the Planning Commission's recommendations on hours of operation and working to establish best practices to improve road safety. The Board disagreed with the recommendation on the application of dust control on the road. The application of dust control on the road would limit the amount of grading that can be done on a road that needs regular grading to keep it drivable. It was also felt that the application of dust control on an already dangerous hill would tend to make it slippery in wet conditions. County 41 is in terrible shape and singling out one land owner to pay for needed repair seems unreasonable.

Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to operate a trucking and repair business in an A3, Urban Fringe district. Approved by County Board – 11/1/2016 (Doc # 636570).

B. Expansion and Amendment of an existing CUP

Proposed amendments to the Jason Augustine (applicant/owner) and Augie's Trucking CUP to allow additional trucks, more parking, and expansion of shop building.

Tasha Miller (Applicant representative) was present to represent the application.

Mike Wozniak (Wozniak) presented the staff report and attachments.

Commissioner Allen; asked if the applicant had anything to add.

The Applicant provided clarification on the hours of operation. Some trucks leave as early as 3:00 am and the repair business hours are Monday – Friday 8:00 am to 6:00 pm (sometimes until 9:00 pm) and Weekends varying daytime/early evening hours.

Wozniak asked how much additional traffic is estimated to be generated by the requested expansion.

Ms. Miller responded that the repair side is slower until April when they will have a contract and expect to see an increase of one truck trip a day.

Commissioner Pettit ask if County Engineer, Greg Isakson, had conducted any investigation into the direction of traffic to the west rather than to the east.

Wozniak said that he recalled that the Township had concerns about travel in that direction and he was not aware of Mr. Isakson's opinion of travel in that direction.

Chair Fox opened the Public Hearing.

Darlene Melsby, PID 42.001.1005, 17676 County 41, She lives an estimated 1,900 feet east of the business. She has concerns about traffic safety with the increased traffic on this road with a hill and curves. She was also concerned about decreased property values. She had spoken to a realtor who thought that the property would be more difficult to market with a trucking business so near.

Laura Kraskey, PID 42.001.1001, 17674 County 41, The next door neighbor, home is located an estimated 750 feet from the business. She had concerns about noise from the trucks, traffic safety, and property values.

Chis Kraskey-, PID 42.001.1001, 17674 County 41, The next door neighbor, home is located an estimated 750 feet from the business. He stated that this is not a safe road under good conditions.

Jody Cronk, PID 42.001.1200, She lives an estimated 2400 feet from the business. She stated-truck traffic is so fast, it is a constantly safety issue for anyone walking or driving on the road. She is concerned about noise, dust, and safety. This is a commercial trucking firm and it is does not belong in the residential or agricultural area.

Sharleen Dudley, PID 42.001.0500, lives an estimated 1300 feet north east of the business. She has concerns about dust and often hears trucks starting at 3:00am. She cannot walk on the road

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any more due to the washouts and truck traffic.

Commissioner Allen asked if she had lived there for 30 years and when did the trucks become a problem?

Dudley said that she had lived at this location for the past 30 years and it was 2 years ago when the trucking became an issue.

Jamie Clemens, PID 42.001.1003, home is an estimated 1300 feet west of the business. He stated that he had been run off the road by Augie's trucking. He also has concerns about the noise.

Karen Pearson, PID 31.006.1500, home is an estimated 3,300 feet east of the business. She has concerns about traffic and farming equipment sharing the road with semi-trucks. The hours are not 8:00- 5:00. There are trucks on the road all hours.

Eric Pearson, PID 31.006.1500, home is an estimated 3,300 feet east of the business. While hauling manure on his farm he witnessed a near collision of a school bus and dump truck, the dump truck was coming the other way and the truck could not stop and swerved off the road, the only good thing was the kids were still on the bus and not on the road. This is a dangerous road and no place for a trucking business to be located.

Karen Pearson, asked if there is another way? There is no good option. A trucking business should not be located here.

Sharleen Dudley asked why there has not been any dust control.

Laura Kraskey, safety and the noise are serious concerns. The trucks are starting at 3:00am.

¹After Chair Fox asked three times for comments. It was moved by Commissioner Feuling and seconded by Commissioner Allen to close the public hearing. Motion carried 6:0

Commissioner Allen asked the applicant what is the primary purpose of the business.

Wozniak stated that the 2016 CUP was approved as a business primarily intended to serve the agricultural community.

Ms. Miller stated that the hauls are mostly to and from the metro for yard clippings and garbage.

Commissioner Allen stated that he applauded the business growing but this does not seem like a business primarily intended to serve the agricultural community.

Mr. Miller asked the neighbors when the last time they heard a truck at 3:00am and stated that dust control was not required in the 2016 CUP.

Several members of the public in attendance stated that they heard trucks starting at 4:00am and 5:00 within the last couple of weeks, but the problem was more audible in the summer.

Commissioner Pettit stated that agricultural uses are often similar to industrial. It is a fact of life in the country, but she took issue with a commercial business out growing an appropriate area.

Commissioner Allen said that the focus is not agricultural anymore. It should grow in an industrial area not out in the County.

Len Fueling asked if the Township had any comments.

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Mike Carlson from Vasa Township Board said that in 2016 the Township was concerned about both traffic patterns. There is no good route, but traveling east to highway 19 is just shorter. The request has not been heard at the Township. Their meeting would be on Tuesday February 13, 2018.

Commissioner Allen asked about dual zoning authority.

Director Hanni stated that the County makes their own decision based of the Goodhue County Ordinance.

The PAC and staff discussed new conditions, dust control, and hours of operation.

There was discussion about the 2016 approved use as business primarily intended to serve the agricultural community use and the hours of operation.

Staff directed the PAC to review the 2016 CUP conditions:

1. The business must comply with all applicable Federal, State and Local Rules and Regulations, including but not limited to building permits and SSTS permits.
2. The applicant shall schedule an inspection by the Goodhue County Building Official to evaluate the accessory structure housing the business for compliance with applicable building code requirements.

Commissioner Gale he was concerned about safety and the number of people being run off the road.

Director Hanni stated that a condition could be added addressing dust control and road safety. The applicant could be directed to work with Public Works to establish best practices for this road.

Ms. Miller added that she understood that they were only limited to 5 trucks owned by Jason Augustine, but they could have more trucks under separate ownership.

Commissioner Pettit would like to see dust control and clear hours of operation 8:00-6:00 added to the CUP conditions.

There was discussion about the limit for number of trucks allowed for the trucking business of 5 trucks, but there was not a truck number limit set for the repair business.

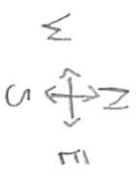

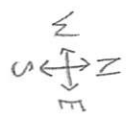

Summary of Project:

The applicant (Jason Banks) is currently utilizing a 30 ft by 40 foot (1200 sq ft) detached accessory structure to operate "JB Heating and Air Conditioning" at his residential property in Florence Township. The commercial use of a detached accessory structure in an R1 zoned district requires prior issuance of an IUP for a Tier-2 Home Business.

Tier-2 Home Businesses are required to receive IUP's in R1 Zoned Districts when employing 2 non-resident employees or when activities are conducted in a detached accessory structure. Expansion to a Tier-3 Home Business is not permissible in an R1 Zoned District.

Goodhue County Zoning Ordinance: Article 4 Conditional/Interim Uses

No CUP/IUP shall be recommended by the County Planning Commission unless said Commission specifies facts in their findings for each case which establish the proposed CUP/IUP will not be injurious to the use and enjoyment of other property in the immediate vicinity for the purposes already permitted, will not substantially diminish and impair property values within the immediate vicinity, will not impede the normal and orderly development and improvement of surrounding vacant property for uses predominant to the area, that adequate measures have been, or will be, taken to provide utilities, access roads, drainage and other necessary facilities, to provide sufficient off-street parking and loading space, to control offensive odor, fumes, dust, noise and vibration so that none of these will constitute a nuisance, and to control lighted signs and other lights in such a manner that no disturbance to neighboring properties will result.

- The main activities on-site are the loading and off-loading of trucks with heating and air conditioning related parts and equipment.
Shipments are typically off-loaded off-street near the applicant's detached garage.
On average, 10 shipments are delivered per month. Monthly shipment quantities fluctuate due to the seasonal demand of the industry.
- No traffic beyond that which is reasonable for the area is anticipated to be generated.
- Primary hours of operation are proposed to be year-round, Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
There are no on-site retail activities. The applicant indicated the shop is usually unoccupied throughout the majority of the day as the work is conducted at the client's property.
- Pursuant to GCZO Article 11, Section 16, minimum off-street parking provisions shall be one parking space for every 500 square feet of floor area. A minimum of 3 off-street parking spaces is required for this facility.
Ample room exists on the property to fulfill parking requirements.
- A restroom is available for employees within the existing residence. A compliant community septic system provides wastewater treatment for the property.
- Solid waste disposal services are provided by a local professional business.
- There is no exterior signage associated with the business on the property. No exterior signage is proposed with this application.
- Recessed garage lights provide exterior lighting for the structure. No additional lighting is proposed.
- No offensive noise, dust, odors, or fumes are anticipated to be generated as a result of the proposed use.

The following provisions are only intended to serve as an “incubator” for rural entrepreneurship. Home Business ventures seeking to expand beyond the scale of “subordinate and incidental” to a principal residential use shall rezone the property to an appropriate zoning district or relocate to an appropriate zoning district.”

Bechel also clarified Conditional Use Permit (CUP) runs with the land and as Interim Use Permit (IUP) is for a temporary period of time, in this case, until the business grows or when the property ownership changes.

Application stated that he works by himself and uses one pickup truck; he loads up and heads out on repairs and installations.

Bechel provided a summary of comments received by the LUM office before the meeting (Abby Lou, Darin Lundel, and three phone calls- attachment) supporting the applicant and the business and concerns about traffic and a homeowners covenants.

Chair Fox opened the Public Hearing.

Peter Darula, PID 32.136.0170, 35305 Farm View Street, This is a residential area and he is opposed to a business in the area. He stated that they had shut down another business in the

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area and this one needs to be shut down too.

Commissioner Allen asked about the other business, it was tire business that had customers, customer's vehicles, and exterior storage. The Bank's requested home business has none of those things. It might be inappropriate to have customers on site for services and sales in a residential area. This is different.

Kevin Dather, PID 32.136.0080, 35443 Eagle Ridge, Banks is just trying to get started. If you get bigger, you have to go to another location. He is retired and home every day. He supports the business and has yet to see any increase in traffic from this home business.

Don Bauch, PID 32.136.0220, 35278 Martin Street, opposed due to traffic and safety.

Melissa Dykes, PID 32.136.0130, 35367 Farm View Street, She is home during the day with 6 8 11 year old girls. There is no traffic. This is ridiculous. This is not going to hurt anything in the neighborhood. Not a problem.

Carlo Halpaus, PID 32.136.0280, 35318 Farm View Street, They live behind the property. She is home all day. There are a lot of trucks and she has concerns about the road conditions.

Virgill Dykes, PID 32.136.0130, 35367 Farm View Street, Has known the applicant for his whole life and supports the proposal. The Banks property is well maintained and the garage matches the house. He has yet to see any delivery trucks other than FedEx and USPS delivery to and from all other homes in the area. No issues.

Jed Clark, PID 32.136.0090, 35425 Eagle Ridge, He owns a very small construction company. The largest truck that goes through the neighborhood is the garbage truck. No problem with what Jason is doing. Rental or office space in Lake City is not financially feasible for a small and just starting out business like this.

Al Settle, PID 32.136.0330, 35325 Martin Street, He lives across the street and is retired and home most of the time; nothing Mr. Banks has done has bothered him. This is not causing any problems.

Connie Settle, PID 32.136.0330, 35325 Martin Street, well kept up property with matching accessory structure and landscaping is appealing and the FedEx truck stops more often at our house than Mr. Banks. He is not bothering anyone. She is fully in support.

Mason Grobe, PID 32.136.0020, 25522 Pepin Visa Ave, He is in support of the applicant.

Cory Wurst, PID 32.136.02600, three houses away and approves everything Jason is doing.

Jeff Applequist PID 32.136.0310, 35291 Martin Street, He has 5 children. Some residents are more affected than others. He is concerned about traffic. He said that he recently signed a home owner covenant listing "no businesses allowed". This is a residential area.

Commissioner Allen asked about home owner covenants.

There is no home owner association to enforce any covenants.

Corry Mikelson, PID 32.136.0200, 35259 Maury Ave, He works nights and has saw a delivery truck come once and a while midmorning. Has no concerns.

Shelly Lavan, PID 32.136.0150, 35335 Farm View, This is a quiet neighborhood. She works from home and it still a quiet neighborhood. She supports approval of the request.

Summary:

The Minnesota Department of Employment and Economic Development has confirmed the eligibility of three census tracts located within Goodhue County and one tract located in Wabasha County. Staff representing each of the areas has met and determined rankings for the eligible tracts.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the EDA Board and the County Board approve the following three eligible census tracts ranked highest to lowest priority for Opportunity Zones in the City of Red Wing, Goodhue County:

1. Tract 802
2. Tract 801.01
3. Tract 801.02

In addition, staff recommends working cooperatively with Wabasha County on their respective applications for Opportunity Zones.

RESOLUTION NO. 7211

A Resolution Establishing Local Priorities for Opportunity Zones in Red Wing

WHEREAS, the Opportunity Zone Program was created as part of the 2017 tax reform package in order to provide opportunities for private investment in low-income urban and rural communities; and

WHEREAS, Minnesota's Governor may forward 123 eligible census tracts to the US Treasury from a total of 491 eligible census tracts within the state that can become Opportunity Zones in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, Goodhue County will complete an application to the Governor that will identify eligible census tracts by priority based on a recommendation from the City of Red Wing for its three (3) eligible census tracts within the city; and

WHEREAS, the city's eligible census tracts include: (1) Tract 801.01 with 65.9% of median household income and 14.1% poverty; (2) Tract 802 with 80.0% of median household income and 18.1% poverty; and (3) Tract 801.02 with no data but is contiguous to the two tracts above; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered said matter at a meeting on February 26, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, based on economic data and geographic opportunities for each census tract, the City Council makes the following conclusions:

1. The City Council prioritizes the three eligible census tracts for Opportunity Zones in the City of Red Wing, highest to lowest, as follows: (1) Tract 802, (2) Tract 801.01, and (3) Tract 801.02.
2. The City Council supports Goodhue County working cooperatively with Wabasha County on their respective applications for Opportunity Zones.

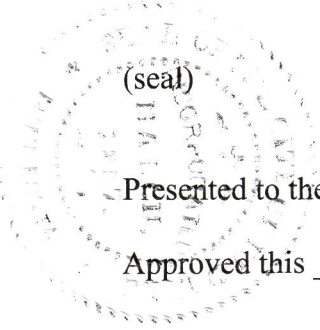

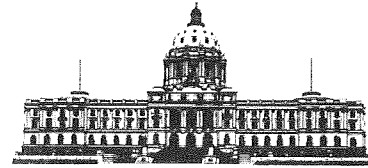
