PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Public Hearing- Revoke County Road 50 to Minneola Township. Staff requested that the County hold a public hearing to discuss revoking the section of CR 50 from 400th St. South to TH 52 and from TH 52 Southwest to TH 57 to Minneola Township and recommends the board approve the proposed resolution.

Greg Isakson reviewed the issue with the board and recommended the board conduct a public hearing to revoke the portion of road to Minneola Township.
